3. GRANT OF DEARNESS ALLOWANCE TO CANTT FUND EMPLOYEES

Reference CBR No.01 dated 04.12.2019.

To consider and approve the grant of Dearness Allowance @ 28% w.e.f. 01.07.2021 instead of the existing rate of 17% on the revised pay structure, to the employees of Cantt. Board, Ambala Cantt in terms of Notification No.4/3/2016-5FR/17937 dated 26.07.2021 issued by Govt. of Haryana.The employees of the Cantonment Board, in terms of Clause 14(1) of the Memorandum of Settlement Cantonment Board employees, are entitled to get the

same wages on the same terms and conditions as per the wages of the employees of the State Government. As the DA has been increased from 17% to 28% w.e.f. 01.07.2021, the Board will have to bear an additional expenditure of Rs.98.00 lac per annum (approx), out of which a sum of Rs. 46.00 lac approx. share will be recovered from the Local Military Authorities under the Conservancy Agreement for the year 2021-22. The sanction of the Higher Authorities is required for making the payment.

RESOLUTION No. 3: Considered and approved. The proposal for grant of dearness allowance be forwarded to the competent authority for according necessary sanction .

4. GRANT OF DEARNESS RELIEF TO PENSIONERS / FAMILY PENSIONERS

Reference CBR No. 02 dated 17.01.2020.

To consider and note the grant of Dearness Relief to Pensioners/Family Pensioners @ 28% w.e.f. 01.07.2021 instead of the existing rate of 17% vide Govt. of Haryana, Deptt. Of Finance, Office Memorandum No.4/1/2019-2FR/18323 dated 27.07.2021. The Cantonment Board Pensioners/family pensioners are also entitled to get the Dearness Relief at par with the State Govt. Pensioners as per DG DE letter No.25/51/L&C/72/PC dated 11.11.1982 and as per PD DE WC letter No.15/396/Cantt/Punjab/DE dated 09.09.2009 the same shall be applicable to the Cantt. Board Employees automatically. The Board will have to bear an extra expenditure of Rs.60.00 lac per annum (approx.) on the grant of Dearness Relief @ 28% w.e.f. 01.07.2021 to the pensioners/family pensioners of the Cantonment Board.

Reference DG, DE, GOI Min. of Def. New Delhi letter No. 76/67/echh-PT/C/ DE/ 2021 dated 09.06.2021.

To consider and approve the matter regarding revision of rates of Demand Notice Fee @ Rs.100/- (Rs.one hundred only) as advised by the DG, DE GOI Min. of Def. New Delhi vide letter No. 76/67/echh-PT/C/DE/2021 dated 09.06.2021 to fix the Demand Notice fee @ Rs.100/- (Rs. one hundred only) of each notice to maintain uniformly and enable its incorporation in the tax module of eChhawani.

Presently the rate of Demand Notice fee is Rs. 50/-, 100/-, & Rs. 200/- in different areas of Cantt. Board, Ambala. As mentioned in the letter referred above, the matter was also discussed in the meeting on echhawani project dated 07.06.2021 taken by the Def. Secy and it was observed that all CEOs would be required to be advised to fix the Demand Notice Fee @ Rs.100/- (Rs. One Hundred only) for each notice to maintain uniformity and enable its incorporation in the tax module of echhawani.

18. AUTHORITY: CWP NO.9206 OF 2021 & APPEAL/LPA ORDER DATED 22.07.2021: GURINDER SINGH BASSAN VS THE DISTRICT MAGISTRATE AND OTHER

To consider the Interim Order of stay passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh on 06.05.2021 in the CWP No.9206 of 2021 filed by Gurinder Singh Bassan against the District Magistrate & others, in which the Hon'ble High Court directed the parties to maintain status quo the running of outlet whereby responded No. 02 i.e. Indian Oil Corporation would be under obligation to supply the fuel as is already being undertaken in respect of bungalow No.99 Alexandra Road, Ambala Cantt. and order dated 22.07 2021 of early hearing for seeking vacation of stay leading to operation of the petrol pump filed by

Cantonment Board against Gurinder Singh Bassan etc. and the Hon'ble High Court dismissed the application of vacation of stay.

The Petitioner Sh. Gurvinder Singh has not impleaded Cantonment Board, Ambala as respondent in the above CWP No. 9206/2021. As the land /property concerned is known as Bungalow No. 99, Alexandra Road, Ambala Cantonment, bearing General Land Register (GLR) Survey No. 353 measuring 1.67 acres, owned by the Government of India, Ministry of Defence. Its occupancy right is held on Old Grant terms, governed under GGO-179 of 1836, by Smt. Dalip Kaur w/o Dr. Arjun Singh for residential purpose. It is situated outside the notified civil area under the management of Defence Estates Officer, Ambala Cantonment.

As the bungalow falls under the jurisdiction of Ambala Cantonment Board and the petitioner mis-representation /mislead to Hon'ble High Court and respondents regarding ownership of the land and necessary No Objection Certificate /clearance /approval as required for setting up of petrol pump has not been sought from this office. Further, it is submitted that the Cantonment Board has already filed an application to implead Cantonment Board Ambala as respondent being a necessary party in the above writ petition.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances the applicant Cantonment Board which is a statutory body/local government to file an appeal/LPA against the ex-parte interim order of stay dated 06.05.2021, as also the order dated 22.07.2021, seeking vacation of stay leading to operation of the petrol pump against the Board's interests. CEO be authorized to file the appeal/LPA before the Hon'ble High Court Chandigarh against the Interim Order dated 06.05.2021 and also the order dated 22.07.2021 and incur the necessary expenditure.

The relevant file is placed on the table.

RESOLUTION NO. 18 : Considered and approved. Resolved that CEO is authorised to file an appeal/LPA in the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh to challenge the interim order of stay passed on 06.05.2021 and also the order dated 22.07.2021 which is against the interest of the Board.
