3. OPERATION/MAINTENANCE OF TUBEWELL IN CANTT. AREA

Reference Spl. CBR No. 09 dated 20.03.2020 and Spl. CBR No. 08 dated 17.05.2021.

To consider the extension of contract for operation/maintenance of tubewell in Cantt. area which was expired on 31.05.2022. Therefore, the contract of previous contractor i.e M/s. Zakhmi Brothers may be extended on the same rates terms and conditions till finalization of tender of Operation/maintenance of tubewell in Cantt. Area.

RESOLUTION NO. 3: Considered and approved. The tender for providing for operation/maintenance of tubewell in Cantt. area extended on the same rates, terms & conditions for three months or upto the date of finalization / execution of fresh tender whichever is earlier.

4. TRANSFER OF DEFENCE LAND MEASURING OF 2.7475658 ACRES TO DFCCIL

Reference CBR No.11 Dated 29.05.2017 and Special CBR No.1 Dated 27.08.2021.

To Consider the matter of transfer of 35.918 acres of defence land (33.170435 acres A-1 Land, 1.8906058 Acres B-4 Land and 0.856960 Acres 'C' Land) to DFCCIL a PSU under Ministry of Railways. The working permission for the transfer of the said land was granted by the Ministry of Defence, GoI vide letter No. 51352/DFC/LW(West)/ 895/ US(L)/D(Lands)/2015 dated 09.09.2015 and the case was taken up jointly by the LMA, DEO and Cantt. Board Ambala. The MOU was signed by the DEO Ambala on EVL basis on 19.02.2018 and the work was started by the DFCCIL being the iconic project, Now the case is being taken up as per EVI basis as per GoI letter no. 11015/2/2012/D(Lands) (Pt) dated 21.10.2020 and the total value of Defence land (35.918 Acres) was estimated to Rs. 1,27,41,35,556/- As per the STR of 2015-

2018, now the LMA has taken up case separately and intimated vide letter no. 1551/3/Q3(L)(Rly) dated 07.05.2022 to Cantt. Board to taken up their case separately.

Now revised working permission has been granted by the MOD on EVI basis vide letter no. 125/US(L)/D(L)/2017 dated 04.04.2022. Therefore a draft MOU has been proposed on the same line and spirit as prepared by the LMA, an amount of Rs.24,08,86,360/- (15,37,58,956 + 8,71,27,404) of B-4 land under the management of DEO and class "C" land under the management of Cantt. Board Ambala is to be transferred to the Cantt. Board. Case for approval of Draft MOU to be signed by the Cantt. Board and DFCCIL.

RESOLUTION NO. 4 : Considered in detail and resolved that the draft MoU be forwarded to DFCCIL for further necessary action.

Earlier the Board vide Special CBR No.1 dated 27.08.2021/ Circular Agenda dated 16.08.2021 has approved the works i.e. 1) Construction of shop-cum-offices, near Capital Cinema. 2) Construction of Primary –cum-Middle School. 3) Construction of Auditorium.

The said works were proposed on the land to be transferred by the LMA measuring 8.445 acres of land in lieu of class 'C' land occupied by them. But transfer of all land will take adequate time, hence it is resolved that the following works be executed:-

1.Construction of shop-cum-offices, on Sy No.211 (presently A1 land) which is proposed by LMA in lieu of Sy No. 208/1 (class C land) occupied by the LMA.

2.Infrastructure upgradation of existing schools (at CB Middle School RHA Parade, CB Primary School RHA Bazar, CB Middle School B.I. Bazar, CB Primary School BC Bazar & Roots Cantonment Public School, RHA Bazar) & Auditorium-cum-Dormitory etc. in Akashdeep Community Hall since these land are already under occupation/ management of Cantonment Board, Ambala.

Further resolved that the case be taken up at the earliest to fully utilize the revised working permission granted by the MOD on EVI basis vide letter No. 125/US(L) /D(L)/2017 dated 04.04.2022.

5. AUCTION OF OCCUPANCY RIGHTS OF SHOPS NEAR SHASTRI PARK RHA BAZAR , AMBALA CANTT.

To consider and approve the highest bids for the occupancy rights, for five years, of below Shops near Shastri Park, RHA Bazar, Ambala Cantt in the public auction held on 26.07.2022 at 1030 hrs. in the office of Cantonment Board, Ambala Cantt, attended by 10 bidders, in response to the Auction Notice No. ACB/ REV/ 2022/827 dated 28.06.2022 which was also published in the newspapers Dainik Jagran, Dainik Bhaskar, & Indian Express on 29.06.2022. All highest bidders have deposited 10 month licence fee as security into the Cantt. Fund Account.

RESOLUTION NO.5: Considered and approved the highest bids for the licence fee rights, for five years from the date of possession of the shops No. 01 to 06 near Shastri Park, RHA Bazar, Ambala Cantt.

6. REFUND OF SECURITY AMOUNT IN RESPECT OF SHOP NO. 02, NEAR INSPECTION BUNGALOW, LAL KURTI BAZAR ROAD, AMBALA CANTT.

The application dated 27.07.2022 from Sh. Manoj Kumar S/o Sh. Sunil Kumar, licensee of shop No.02, Near Inspection Bungalow, Lal Kurti Bazar Road, Ambala Cantt regarding refund of security amount deposited by him at the time of bidding for the above shop for a period of five years w.e.f. 25.10.2021 to 24.10.2026. He has requested to this office vide letter dated 25.07.2022 that he wants to surrender the shop and hand over the possession to Cantonment Board. The applicant has handed over the vacant possession of the said shop on 25.07.2022. The applicant has further requested to refund the balance security amount after deducting the licence fee as well as service tax/GST payable by him upto 25.07.2022.

It is further mentioned here that the licensee had deposited Rs.295000/- as security amount into Cantt. Fund Account. License fee of Rs.177000/- plus Rs.31860/- GST + Fine Rs.36875/- amounting to a total of Rs.245735/- are outstanding against the shop upto 25.07.2022 be adjusted from the security and balance Rs.49265/- be refunded to the licensee.

As per clause 11 of the agreement, the shop holder may surrender the shop to the Chief Executive Officer at any time by giving three month clear notice in writing. In lieu of notice the shop holder will have to pay the license amount.

7. WORK EXECUTED THROUGH LOCAL PURCHASE COMMITTEE

The following work/procurement of item has been done on exigency basis through local purchase committee:-

1. Operation/maintenance of 5TPD waste processing system opposite cremation ground, Panjokhra Road, Ambala Cantt. Rs. 1,00,000/- out of Cantt. fund.
2. Construction water body at Mall road near B.No. 42, Ambala Cantt Rs. 1,98,800/- out of Urban Local Body Funds.
3. Repair/Re-construction of drain A/F tubewell along Race Course road, Ambala Cantt. Rs. 1,96,137/-out of Urban Local Body Fund.
4. Supply and fixing of underground pipe for drainage on Park road and near Sub area Park. Rs. 1,85,060/-out of Urban Local Body Funds.
5. Supply and fixing of stainless steel gate and railing in Cantonment Guest House. Rs. 1,95,560/-out of Urban Local Body Funds.

8. PROSECUTIONS : SECTION 331 OF CANTONMENTS ACT, 2006

Reference CBR NO. 36 dated 07.05.2007.

To consider and authorize the Conservancy Jamadar/outdoor staff of Sanitation Section to challan under Section 277/283 & 289 of the Cantonments Act, 2006 and to lodge complaints under Sections 331 in the courts for prosecutions for the offences punishable under the provisions of the Cantonments Act, 2006 other than the offences specified in the schedule IV of the Act.

All the relevant papers are placed on the table.

RESOLUTION NO. 8: Considered and resolved to authorize the Conservancy Jamadars and Sh. Sanjay Kumar, Assistant Sanitation Section to take action u/s 277/283 & 289 of the Cantonments Act, 2006 and to lodge complaints under Section 331. This authorization is for six months i.e. upto February, 2023. Performance will be reviewed and further decision will be taken in due course.

9. FIXING THE CHARGES FOR THE DESLUDGING OF PRIVATE SEPTIC TANK THROUGH SUCTION JET MACHINE IN CANTT AREA

To consider the office report dated 22.06.2022 for engaging the suction jet machine for the desludging of private septic tank in Cantonment area. Keeping in view the cost of diesel and maintenance of vehicle, the charges of Rs.1500/- is recommended.

The office report alongwith relevant file is placed on the table.

RESOLUTION NO. 9: Considered and approved.

10. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT & DUMPING SITE :

Reference Spl. CBR No.9 dated 27.8.2021 vide which the Board resolved to execute an agreement with the agency M/s Pooja Consultation registered office at 663/27 Dev Nagar, Sonipat. In the light of the resolution referred above, the Cantonment Board entered into an agreement on 09.11.2021 the rate for processing of waste was Rs.794/- per metric tonne and the period of contract was for one year commencing w.e.f. 10.11.2021 to 09.11.2022. On 10.05.2022, the agency M/s Pooja Consultation registered office at 663/27 Dev Nagar, Sonipat stopped accepting garbage at their Patvi Plant stating that ULB Haryana & as per NGT guidelines, they are not accepting fresh garbage but only legacy waste is allowed to treat at their plant. Various meetings have been held in the office of the President Cantt Board cum Station Commander with LMA, Municipal Corporation Ambala City officials & Cantt. Board officials and an agency M/s Suntan life Corporate Office, 937, Sector 2, Panchkula, Haryana which is working with the Municipal Corporation Ambala City, agreed for processing of solid waste received at their site Jatwar village @ 893/- per tonne on the following terms & conditions:-

- i) The waste shall be transported at their processing facility on daily basis by the Cantonment Board.
- ii) Taxes shall be charged extra as applicable.
- iii) Certificate for the waste processed shall be provided on monthly basis to the bulk waste generator.
- iv) The detailed terms & conditions to be mentioned in the agreement before the start of the above services.
- v) The firm shall not provide bio-medical waste disposal services.

In addition to that the firm through email dated 28.06.2022 has intimated that the firm is in process of installing a weigh bridge at their plant site, till then the vehicles sent by Cantt. Board Ambala are to be weighed outside the plant at a private weigh

bridge on the Cantonment Board cost. The expenditure will be met out of the conservancy agreement with the LMA.

RESOLUTION NO. 10: Considered and approved. CEO is authorized to execute an agreement with M/s Suntan life Corporate Office, 937, Sector 2, Panchkula, Haryana w.e.f. 23.06.2022 as the work has already been started. The expenditure will be met out of the conservancy agreement with the LMA for the current financial year for which case be taken up with LMA immediately.

11. ENGAGEMENT OF 03 SANITARY INSPECTORS ON CONTRACTUAL BASIS :

It is mentioned that there are sanctioned strength of 03 Sanitary Inspectors(02 for Army & 01 for Civil area) to supervise the Sanitation of Cantonment area. Presently for the last 02 years, there is no Sanitary Inspector in the Cantonment Board to look after the sanitation services. Since the National Programme Swachh Survekshan & ODF is also running very effectively in the country and in the absence of supervisory staff i.e. Sanitary Inspectors, the sanitation services provided by the Cantonment Board is affected.

It is therefore, requested that the services of 03 Sanitary Inspectors (02 for Army Area & 01 for Civil Area) be hired on contract basis from the existing contractor M/s Laxmi Security (Gujarat) Pvt Ltd Ahmedabad engaged under present contract w.e.f. 01.04.22 to 31.03.2023 on the payment of wages as per Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam fixed vide Notification No.16/71/2021-3GS-II dated 19.01.2022 under category II & list of Job Roles of Level-III (Annexure –C) in S.No.7 under head “Technical Professional” @ Rs. 19,120 + EPF, ESI as applicable. The expenditure on account of salary of 02 Sanitary Inspectors engaged for Army area shall be met out under Head F(9)Army Conservancy Agreement.

The relevant file along with office report is placed on the table.

RESOLUTION NO. 11: Considered in detail and resolved that two Sanitary Inspectors (one from head civil conservancy & second from head Military conservancy) be engaged on the contractual basis from the existing contractor M/s Laxmi Security (Gujarat) Pvt Ltd Ahmedabad at Ist Phase for the period of six months. Their services will be reviewed after six months if the services are found satisfactory then they will be engaged for further period. Third Inspector be engaged from the head Military Conservancy after concurrence of the necessary expenditure from the PCDA WC. The expenditure on account of salary of 01 Sanitary Inspector engaged for Army area shall be met out under head Military Conservancy.

12. ISSUE OF NOTICE UNDER SECTION 248 OF THE CANTONMENT ACT, 2006: B.NO. 105, MALL ROAD, AMBALA CANTT.

To sanction the issue of notice under section 248 of the Cantonment Act, 2006 to Sh. Vikram Yadav, Smt. Madhu R Bhogal W/o Sh. Ravinder Singh Bhogal & Smt. V Madan W/o Sh. Surjan Singh Madan, unauthorised occupant/HOR/ Occupiers/ Offenders of Bungalow No. 105, Mall Road, Ambala Cantt for the following unauthorised construction as per laid on the table and to sanction the prosecution under section 247 of the Cantonment Act, 2006:-

EXTRA ITEMS TAKEN WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR :

15. SEEKING PERMISSION TO OPEN LIQUOR VEND IN CANTONMENT BOARD AREA

1. Reference order dated 22.07.2022 of Civil Judge (Jr Divn.) Ambala Dr. Mukesh Kumar in civil suit 1306 of 2022 titled Vijay Kumar Garg Vs Cantonment Board etc.
2. Reference Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner (Excise) Ambala office letter No.905 EXA/ dated 29.07.2022.
- 3 Reference application dated 08.08.2022 received from Sh.Vijay Kumar Garg,5-C Rani Bagh, Ambala Cantt.
4. Reference Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner (Excise) Ambala office letter No.849 EXA/ dated 08.08.2022.

In reference to S.No.1 referred above, it is submitted Civil Judge (Junior Division) Ambala that the court has ordered that it will be appropriate if plaintiff be directed to apply to the Cantonment Board for necessary permission as per section 277 of Cantonments Act,2006 "**Licenses required for carrying on of certain occupations (j) Vendors of spirituous liquor**"and the Cantonment Board shall decide application within 10 days from its received. Accordingly, plaintiff is hereby directed to file necessary application before concerned authority of Cantonment Board within seven days from the date of order and the Cantonment Board shall decide his application within 10 days from receiving.

In this matter S.No.2 referred above, the Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner (Excise) Ambala has requested to allow vend operational for the current year i.e. Excise financial year 2022-23 as removal of Liquor vend could seriously hamper the proceedings of the Haryana Excise Policy and shall also be detrimental for the State Revenue. Moreover, a liquor vend in the said area would be greatly advantageous to both the Cantonment Board as well as State of Haryana as a serious law and order issue could be created due to probable supply illegal and spurious liquor. The Cantonment Board of Ambala is also close to the border of Punjab and there may be interstate smuggling leading to heavy loss of state revenue and also posing grave security concerns for Cantonment Board. He assured that the specific vend would only be continued in the next Excise year only after taking prior written permission from this office in this regard, otherwise it will not be allowed to open and requested to allow the vend as mentioned above for the current year 2022-23 in the interest of Govt. revenue.

Further S.No.3 referred above, Sh. Vijay Kumar Garg has requested to allow the liquor vend in the name of Tundla at Topkhana Parade Chowk to continue its operation during the year 2022-23.

In addition to above S.No.2: S.No.4 referred above, the Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner (Excise) Ambala has allowed the following four sites mentioned in the letter referred above :-

1. Tundla : from Vishnu Jewellers to Cantonment Board CBA Lake on Topkhana Road, within the Municipal Limit, Ambala.
2. Defence Colony: From Happy Book Depot to Guliani Super Store near HDFC Bank either side on Defence Colony to Kalerheri Road, within the Municipal Limit Ambala.
3. Joy Palace: From Sonu Water Tanker & Building Material to Fateh Singh Filling Station either side on Naraingarh Road, within the Municipal Limit, Ambala City.
4. NaraingarhMor, Ambala City: From NaraingarhMor to Shree Krishna Hospital either side on Naraingarh Road, within the Municipal Limit, Ambala City.

Out of which one, the area is under the management of Cantonment Board Ambala i.e. **“Tundla : from Vishnu Jewellers to Cantonment Board CBA Lake on Topkhana Road, within the Municipal Limit, Ambala”**. The total bid price of Rs.5,18,75,000/- for four sites offered by Sh. Vijay Kumar Garg, 5-C Rani Bagh, Ambala Cantt.

It is informed that the Board resolved vide CBR No.11 dated 11.03.1992 & CBR No.4 dated 07.06.2000 that no liquor wine shop be allowed in Cantonment limit.

The matter is placed before the Board for taking necessary decision.

RESOLUTION NO. 15 : Considered in detail and resolved that trade license be issued to Sh. Vijay Kumar Garg, Ambala Cantt for “Tundla : from Vishnu Jewellers to Cantonment Board CBA Lake on Topkhana Road, within the Municipal Limit, Ambala” based on the request from Dy. Excise and Taxation Commissioner (Excise), Ambala. This one site is approximately Rs. 1.25 Cr. and Board resolved that 3% be taken up from the applicant as a trade license fee i.e. Rs.3,89,062.5/- for the excise period 12.06.2022 to 11.06.2023. He will abide all the

conditions mentioned in Excise Policy of Govt. of Haryana, relevant sections of Cantonments Act, 2006. Further, the applicant may apply for taking shop/khokha on license fees of Cantonment Board, Ambala for running the liquor shop and for this the applicant shall execute an agreement with Cantonment Board Ambala and will pay license fee separately for the shop/khokha for a period of 01 year only.
