**2. OUTSOURCING OF CONSERVANCY SERVICES FOR AMBALA
CANTONMENT W.E.F. 01.10.2023 TO 31.03.2024**

Reference GOC-in-Chief, Chandimandir Case No.57758/24/Ambala/2023-24/Q3(B) dated 07.08.2023 concurred by IFA(WC)/Outsourcing/CS/Ambala/AoN-123 dated 31.07.2023.

Bid on Government e Marketplace (GeM) portal for hiring of manpower of 425 Nos. sweeper for conservancy services in Ambala Cantonment area. was published on 25.08.2023 vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2023/B/3875333 dated 25.08.2023 and bid end date was 09.09.2023. In response of GeM bid for hiring of Manpower outsourcing services of 425 Nos unskilled sweeper, 174 bids were received by 09.09.2023. Out of 174 bids, six firms have submitted documents physically as required in RFP clause 2 a(ii)(ab)(ac). Out of six bidders only four have been qualified and remaining two bidders alongwith other one hundred sixty eight bidders were

rejected due to non submission of physically documents as required. An opportunity was given to the disqualified bidders to upload/submit the required documents as per RFP clause 2 a(ii)(ab)(ac) within forty eight hours as per guidelines of GeM portal. Out of 170 disqualified bidders, twenty eight bidders have replied and uploaded the documents. On scrutiny of the documents, only one firm have uploaded the required documents hence qualified. No bidder has deposited the documents in the tender box as per bid clause/RFP. On technical evaluation, five firms were found admitted/ qualified for financial evaluation. The financial bids of all the technically qualified firms (five) were opened on 18.09.2023. On the financial evaluation by the GeM portal M/s Oriental Integrated Facility Management Pvt. Ltd Mumbai has quoted the service charges @3.85 % (total price Rs.46393292.07 as L-I is as under :-

3. ROW CLEARANCE ONLY FOR ARMY AREA : ASCON PH-IV.

Reference Special CBR No.4 dt. 22.09.2021.

To consider the letter no. PC-2709/SC/Sigs/Gen/ASCON PH-IV dated 26.08.2023 received from 2 Corps Grid Sig Regt (Aren) C/o 56 APO Ambala Cantt for row clearance only for Army area of underground optical Fibre Cable (OFC) for one of the project of Indian Army Station Ambala. The length of OFC to be laid is 5.4 Km. The project is only for use of Army authorities and no commercial use. In this regard, it is recommended that the applicant may be asked to laying OFC subject to the condition that no municipal facilities of the Board are damaged and in case the roads berms are cut the same will be make good by the applicant agency and in case there is any requirement for removing/replacing/shifting the OFC cable for municipal infrastructure facilities, if required by the Board the OFC cable will be replaced/realigned by the agency at their Cost. The execution of the rest of the project is permitted subject to the following condition:-

- 1) That there should not be any damage to the Cantt. fund property along the route during the execution of the work.
- 2) That there should not be any obstruction to the free flow of the sewage water.

- 3) That there should not be any Road, P.C.C paver block cutting etc. Damage if any shall be assessed by the Cantonment Board Ambala Cantt and the agency has to compensate the loss to the Cantt. Fund property to the satisfaction of the CEO or to pay the damage assessed by the Cantt. Board and approved by the board.
- 4) That the OFC network shall not be used for commercial purposes and will only be used for bona fide defence services.
- 5) That there should not be any tree cutting during the laying of OFC.
- 6) That necessary safety precautions measures shall be taken by the executing agency to enclose the excavated pits to avoid any mishappening, accident and applicant will be responsible for any failure/negligence leading to any accident.
- 7) That in future, for the infrastructure development along the road sides, this office may execute any type of developmental works along this route viz laying of sewer lines, water supply lines etc. For which the OFC cable shall be shifted by the applicant at their risk a cost. Resulting in damage of cable.

4. PROCUREMENT OF REFUSE COMPECTOR 08 CUM MOUNTED ON TATA CHASSIS (LPT-1112) ON GEM PORTAL

Reference DG DE letter No. 56/15/Misc/DGDE/Coord/Vol-III-FMS-70445 dated 10.01.2023 regarding Vehicle Scrapping Police and requisition No. 33(1612) dated 20.02.2023 for procurement/ replacement of one Refuse Collector on TATA Chassis LPT 1112, BS IV, 125 BHP with other specifications laid down in office report dated 01.02.2023 as the old refuse compactor is more than 16 years old and as per vehicle scrapping police the vehicles older than 15 years may be replaced. The same specifications refuse compactor as required is available on GeM portal and this office has published GeM bid vide bid No. GEM/2023/B/3171919 dated 22.02.2023. In response to GeM bid, 08 firms have participated in the bid. Out of 8 bidders, only 3 bidders are technically qualified with the desired specifications and requirement. However GeM portal has granted an opportunity to disqualified bidders to upload the documents as per GeM Bid. No one replied and uploaded the documents. 10. PROVN. OF AUDITORIUM: RECLASSIFICATION OF B-4 LAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTION OF AUDITORIUM

To consider the matter regarding the reclassification of land for the construction of Auditorium in Cantt. Area.

As present there is no auditorium under the Cantt. Board for the public welfare Activities as well as for holding public function and inter school cultural meets etc.

Hon'ble Home Minister Haryana Government Sh. Anil Vij during his meeting with the DC Ambala and CEO Cantt. Board on 06.05.2023 has directed to construct an Auditorium in Cantonment area for usage of public as well as Govt. functions of Ambala Cantt. Similar to the "INDRADHANUSH" constructed by the Haryana Government in Panchkula having capacity 1350. The site near Tribune colony was inspected on the same day by the Hon'ble Minister along with Cantt. Board officials and State Govt. Officials and found most suitable for the purpose. The Hon'ble Minister has assured that the funds for the purpose will be provided by the state Government.

Therefore it is proposed to reclassify the B-4 vacant land bearing Sy No.208 measuring 0.64 acre to Class 'C' land under the management of Cantonment Board Ambala (Vested to Cantt. Board) for the construction of Auditorium.

RESOLUTION NO. 10: Considered. At present on requisite site 'C' land is of one acre and rest of the land is under the management of Army and DEO Ambala.
