Reference DG DE letter No. 56/15/Misc/DGDE/Coord/Vol-III-FMS-70445 dated 10.01.2023 regarding Vehicle Scrapping Policy.

A requisition No. 33(1614) dated 16.06.2023 of sanitation section for procurement/ replacement of one Refuse Collector on TATA Chassis LPT 1112, BS IV, 125 BHP with other specifications laid down in office report as the old refuse compactor is more than sixteen years old. As per vehicle scrapping policy, the vehicles older than fifteen years may be replaced. The same specifications for refuse compactor is available on GeM portal and this office has published GeM bid vide bid No. GEM/2023/B/3617737 dated 26.06.2023. In response to GeM bid, twelve (12) firms have participated in the bid and only one bidder is technically qualified with the desired specifications and requirement. However GeM portal has granted an opportunity to disqualified bidders to upload the documents as per GeM Bid. Three bidders replied and uploaded the documents. Out of three bidder, two

bidders has uploaded the documents as desired in the GeM bid and hence qualified. Financial bid of three technically qualified firms opened on 20.11.2023. The comparative statement for the same as per Gem is as under:-

The work of sanitation / door to door collection of dry and wet waste garbage will be improve on the procurement of two nos. above referred hopper tipper dumper 3.5 cubic meter capacity.

As the Ambala Cantonment is surrounded by Defence colony, Airport, Highway etc by procuring the such type vehicle mounted litter picker machine will improve on efficiency of sanitation worker by coving the large area of Cantonment, which leads to saving of time and manpower. This litter picker machine is to be capable of picking up paper, plastic bottles, broken glass wet and dry leaves and twinges, horticulture waste, garbage and various other types of litters.

Accordingly, this office has published a custom GeM bid vide No. GEM/2023/B/4172706 dated 04.11.2023 and bid end date was 25.11.2023. In response to GeM bid, three firms have participated in the bid.
