To consider the office report on the review of the “School for Special Children Vatsalya”, there are 123 nos. of students in the school. Out of 123 Nos. of students the age of 22 students are more than 18 years. The trainers and the helping staff of the school are facing more difficulties to provide care and training to these types of students who are more than 18 years with the students of lower age group. It is recommended for the better education/training to the special students that the age of the students should not be more than 18 years on 1st April every year.

**RESOLUTION NO. 23: Considered and approved the age limit of the students should be below 18 years as on 01<sup>st</sup> April of the academic year. Further a committee is constituted consisting of four staff members i.e. Sh. Prem Kumar Dhamija, Office Supdt., Sh. Satish Kumar, Assistant Engineer, Sh. Yash Pal, Principal ‘Vatsalya’ School and Smt Deepika Sharma, Head Teacher to evaluate that how these students who are above 18 years can be rehabilitated into the society by means of vocational training or any other livelihood with the contribution of the NGOs. **25. UPGRADATION OF C.B. HIGH SCHOOL, RHA PARADE, AMBALA CANTT.**

The Board was upgraded two Cantonment Board Middle Schools as High School in RHA Parade and B.I. Bazar from the Academic Session 2023-24 vide CBR referred above. Presently 960 Nos. of students in C.B. High School, RHA Parade. Out of these 66 Nos. of students are studying in 10<sup>th</sup> class. As per report of Principal, there is a demand/requirement to upgrade the school as Senior Secondary School by starting 10+1 from the ensuing academic session 2025-26 in the Humanities and Commerce stream. There will be requirement of extra rooms and additional teaching staff from the new academic session for smooth functioning of school.

Additional teaching and non-teaching staff as per actual requirement be engaged from the existing contractor and to initiate necessary action for the extension of infrastructure and to procure the necessary equipment, furniture etc.**

**26. CWP NO. 2224 DATED 19.11.2024: SMT. SWEETY OBEROI VS THE DIRECTOR, DEFENCE ESTATES, WESTERN COMMAND AND OTHERS: COURT CASE FILED BY SMT. SWEETY OBEROI, JUNIOR STENOGRAPHER, CANTONMENT BOARD AMBALA IN THE HON'BLE HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB & HARYANA, CHANDIGARH.**

To consider CWP No. 29963 dated 04.11.2024: Smt. Sweety Oberoi Vs the Director, Defence Estates, Western Command and others i.e., Court case filed by Smt. Sweety Oberoi, Junior Stenographer, Cantonment Board Ambala in which she prayed to the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh in Para-24 of the writ petition.

- (i) *“Issue an appropriate Writ, Order of Direction in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No. 1 and 2 to promote the petitioner to the post of Assistant from the date of promotion granted to her juniors namely Sanjay Kumar and Dharminder Kumar, the respondent No 3 and 4 or directions be issued to the respondents No.1 and 2 to consider the grant of pay scale of Senior Scale Stenographer to the petitioner, as recommended by respondent No.2 to the respondent No. 1, vide letter dated 19.05.19, attached as Annexure P-10.*
- (ii) *Further directions be issued to the respondent to release all the consequential benefits arising out of promotion to the post of Assistant, such as pay scale, arrear of pay, seniority etc. along with interest @ 12% from the date, the persons junior to her were promoted to the post of Assistant.*
- (iii) *Further prayer directions may kindly be issued not to consider the case of Sanjay Kumar and Dharminder Kumar for further promotion to the post of Superintendent during the pendency of the present Civil Writ Petition.*
- (iv) *Or pass any order, which the Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper as per facts and circumstances of the case.*
- (v) *To dispensed with the fling of the certified copies of the annexures and supply of advance notice to the respondents.”*

Earlier Smt. Sweety Oberoi served a legal notice to this through her legal counsel Sh. Surinder Gandhi, Advocate Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh on 21.10.2024 with the request for promotion to the post of Assistant from the date Sanjay Kumar and Dharminder Kumar, who are junior to her were promoted to the post of Assistant or she may be promoted to the post of senior scale stenographer.

The Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh has heard the case on 06.11.2024 and disposed of the case above writ petition with the order dated 06.11.2024 received in this office on 25.11.2024 vide disposed of no. 2224 (w-18/Writs) dated 19.11.2024 as follows:

*“In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-13) within 04 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to her and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to her interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.”*

The brief of the service detail of Smt. Sweety Oberoi is as under:

- (i) She was appointed as a Steno Typist on 30.11.1990 in the pay scale of Rs. 950-1500 + 100 Special Pay vide this office letter No. E-1/1990/1650 dated 26.11.1990.
- (ii) The post of Steno Typist was upgraded vide PDDE, WC, Chandigarh letter No. 9492/B/Cantt/DE/47 dated 10.06.1999 and filled by Smt. Sweety Oberoi, Steno Typist and she availed the financial benefits on her promotion i.e., the pay scale of Rs. 4000-6000 from the date of upgradation of the post.
- (iii) She submitted her representations for the post of promotion as Assistant vide letter dated 22.06.2004, 10.09.2004 and this office replied vide letter No. E-1/2004/2316 dated 21.09.2004.
- (iv) She has already availed the benefits of IInd and IIIrd ACPS on the completion of 18 and 24 years of regular satisfactory service.
- (v) She was applied for the upgradation of the post of Junior Scale Stenographer to Senior Scale Stenographer and her case was considered by the Board time to time as follows:
  - (a) vide CBR No. 130 dated 06.05.2008
  - (b) vide CBR No. 17 dated 09.08.2012
  - (c) vide CBR No. 12 dated 11.05.2016
- (vi) Her case was forwarded to the PDDE vide this office letter No. ACB/OS/2015/33 dated 17.04.2015

- (vii) The PDDE was raised some queries vide their office letter No. 9492/B/Cantt/DE dated 05.08.2015 and 9492/B/Cantt/DE dated 26.02.2016.
- (viii) This office submitted the reply of the above said letter vide this office letter No, ACB/OS/2015/124 dated 20.10.2015 and ACB/OS/2016 dated 19.05.2016.
- (ix) After that this office have not received any reply till date.
- (x) Presently, she is working as a Junior Scale Stenographer.

The matter with the relevant file is placed on the table for consideration.

**RESOLUTION NO. 26: Considered in detail. Further resolved:**

- (i) To forward the reminder to the PDDE, WC of the proposal dated 19.05.2016 for the upgradation of post of Junior Scale Stenographer to Senior Scale Stenographer as resolved by the Board earlier, and no decision/ reply of the PDDE office has been received since 2016.**
- (ii) A committee of three staff members (Supervisory Staff) Office Supdt., Asstt. Engineer and Accountant is hereby constituted to examine the matter of representation and other points mentioned in the legal notice and CWP filed by Smt. Sweety Oberoi with the consultation of Legal Advisor of Cantonment Board and any other expertise in the service matters. The committee will submit the report to the Board up to 28.02.2025.**
- (iii) To review the combined seniority list as per rule.**

**27. REPRESENTATION OF SH. SANJAY KUMAR, ASSTT. FOR PROMOTION**

Reference representation of Sh. Sanjay Kumar, Asstt. Sanitation Branch for promotion for the post of Supdt. dated 16.08.2024, 28.08.2024, 15.10.2024 & 09.12.2024, the brief of the case is as under:

1. Sh. Sanjay Kumar was appointed as Conservancy Jamadar on 18.08.1987 and joined his duty on 20.08.1987 as Conservancy Jamadar (Group-‘D’).
2. The Board vide CBR No. 18 dated 09.07.1992 considered his request for confirmation as Clerk from date of his appointment dated 20.08.1987 as he is performing the duty of Clerk since his appointment and resolved be treated as Clerk. His seniority was fixed from the date of CBR i.e. 09.07.1992.

3. During the year 2000 and 2001, he availed leave from the office and qualified the regular diploma of Sanitary Inspector from All India Institute of Local Self Government, New Delhi.

4. Sh. Sanjay Kumar was deputed as Sanitary Inspector on temporary basis vide office order no. 408 dated 22.06.2001 and vide office order No. 540 dated 14.12.2001 and also availed the financial benefits of the pay scale of sanitary Inspector.

5. In the year 2005, Sh. Sanjay Kumar requested to the Board for confirmation of his services as Sanitary Inspector on the ground that he passed the diploma of Sanitary Inspector from All India Institute of Local Self Government, New Delhi and fulfill the represent qualification of Sanitary Inspector and is officiating a Sanitary Inspector since 2001 against the vacant post.

6. The Board considered his request and forwarded the case to the GoC-in-Chief, Western Command for regularization his services as Sanitary Inspector vide CBR No. 10 dated 24.11.2005.

7. The PDDE, WC, Chandigarh was considered the case and informed to this office that the appointment of Sh. Sanjay Kumar as Sanitary Inspector is violation of Govt. Instructions dated 04.12.1976 as amended and contained in Para (e) of Annexure (c) of under Rule 5(B)(5) of CFSR 1937 and advised to follow the procedure for recruitment the post of Sanitary Inspector.

8. Sh. Sanjay Kumar was promoted as Assistant from the post of Clerk vide office order no. 120 dated 08.11.2007.

9. Sh. Sanjay Kumar was again posted in the Sanitation Branch to perform the duty and taken over the charge from Sh. Ram Phool Yadav, Sanitary Inspector vide office order no. 128 dated 29.12.2015 and on the retirement of Sh. Bhoop Singh, Sanitary Supdt. he is performing the another duties in Sanitation Branch vide office order no. 23 dated 26.02.2016.

10. He is still working in Sanitation Branch.

11. It is pertinent to mention here that the following employees filed a writ petition no. CWP No. 1825 of 2020 in the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh as follow:

1. Sanjay s/o Madan Lal aged about 55 years r/o H.No. 3, Rambagh Road, Baluman ki Bagichi, Ambala Cantt, Haryana.
2. Om Prakash s/o Sh. Bansi Lal aged about 57 years, r/o H.No. 7A CBA Colony, Topkhana Bazar, Ambala Cantt, Haryana.
3. Netra Pal Singh s/o Mahendra aged about 31 years, r/o H.No. B699(41) OHC, Ward No. 5, Railway Colony, Ambala Cantt, Haryana.

Versus

1. Union of India, Ministry of Defence, North Block, New Delhi through Director General Defence Estates.
2. Cantonment Board, Ambala, 229, Race Course Road, Ambala Cantt, Haryana through its Chief Executive Officer.
3. Sanjay Kumar Bansal s/o Ved Bhushan, Assistant, Sanitation Department, cantonment Board, Ambala Cantt, Haryana.

12. The above said employees mentioned at S.No. 1 to 3 (Petitioners) filed the CWP in the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh on the following ground:

- (i) The appointment of Sh. Sanjay Kumar is not in order as per CFSR 1937.
- (ii) The regularization of appointment of Sh. Sanjay Kumar as Clerk is not in order as per CFSR 1937.
- (iii) His posting in Sanitation Branch as Sanitary Inspector from time-to-time is not in order.

13. This office submitted the reply of the petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh on 01.04.2021 on the behalf of Union of India and Cantonment Board Ambala.

14. This CWP No. 1825 of 2020 is still pending in the Court and on 09.12.2024 the case was adjourned for date of next hearing.

15. On the retirement of Sh. Naresh Sharma, Tax & Revenue Supdt. on 31.08.2024 was requested for the promotion on the post of Supdt. on the ground that he is senior most Assistant in the office.

16. Sh. Sanjay Kumar, Assistant also served a notice through his Legal Counsel Sh. Subhash Aggarwal, Advocate, Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh on 29.08.2024 and requested as follows:

*“So under these above circumstances I am issuing a Legal Notice to you to stop further promotion to the employees during the pendency of writ petition no. 1825 of 2020 in the Hon’ble High Court till the decision of the case, failing which my client shall approach to the competent authority/court to take the action.”*

17. Sh. Sanjay Kumar is senior most Assistant as per combined seniority list finalized by the Board and circulated vide CBR No. 34 dated 11.05.2017.

The relevant file is placed on the table for consideration.

**RESOLUTION NO. 27: Considered in detail. Further resolved to initiate necessary action as follows:**

- (i) To forward the reply to the legal notice dated 29.08.2024 to the Legal Counsel Sh. Subhash Aggarwal, Advocate, Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh that no promotion to the employees will be initiated during the pendency of Writ Petition No. 1825 of 2020 till the decision of the case of his client.**
- (ii) To obtain the legal opinion of the CBLA and from the Legal Counsel of the Union of India who is defending this case in the Hon’ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh as the CWP is pending in the Court.**
- (iii) A committee constituted vide CBR No.26 mentioned above in the case of Smt. Sweety Oberoi, Junior Scale Stenographer will also examine the matter of the representation submitted by Sh.
